The Nursing Program at WSCC requires a minimum composite (or superscore) ACT score of 18, minimum GPA of 2.5 of all nursing required academic courses, and a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0. The UAB/WSCC NWI Scholarship Program requires completion of all nursing academic courses prior to application to the Nursing program. Once you have met all the requirements listed above you are ready to apply!

Applications are open March 15 – May 15 for Fall start and July 1 – October 1 for Spring start. The application will require documentation of your coursework, you can use your Degree Works to satisfy this requirement, for your ACT score check your Degree Works or you can submit proof of your ACT score with a screen shot of your score report from ACT.org.
